Late Work

Late work will be accepted on or before the day the unit test is administered.

Missing assignments for unit replaced with the unit test grade.

Explanation of Zeroes

Use code "Missing" (calculates as a zero, but not listed as a zero)

"Missing" assignments for unit replaced with a test grade at the end of the unit.

Major Quizzes: Exhaust all possibilities for students to take the quiz. If not taken, replace by the unit test grade

Reassessment

Additional instruction needed before reassessment can be done

Any student failing grade on summative assessment may be given an opportunity for additional instruction and reassessment provided that the student has:

- Participated in class, completed assignments, demonstrated evidence of best effort

Make-up Work

When student is missing work due to an excused absence, teachers shall:

- Provide all relevant assignments, consider length and reason for absence when determining which & when assignment will be due, accept and assess all assigned make-up work, provide reasonable and flexible deadlines

Excessive absences on a case-by-case basis.

Work will be graded without penalty. Follow guidelines for late work above.
